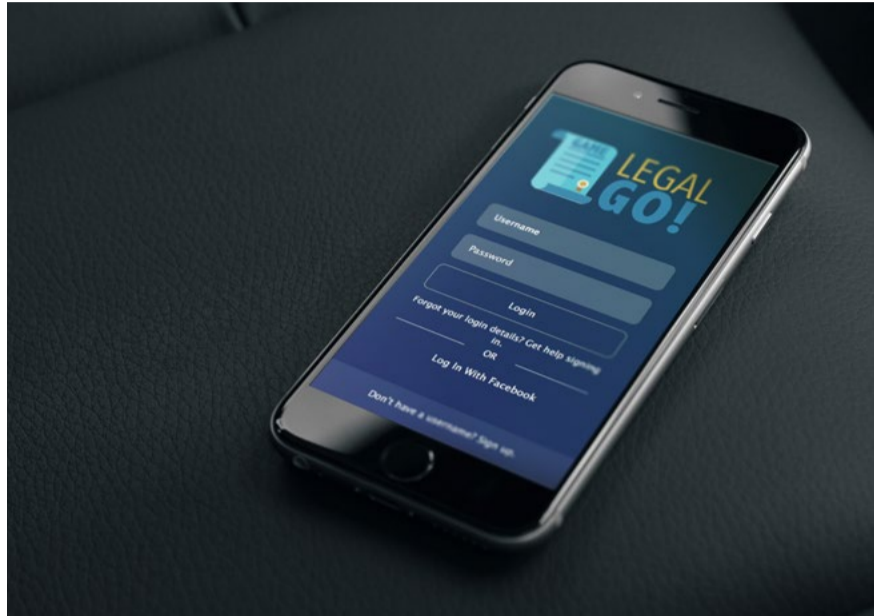

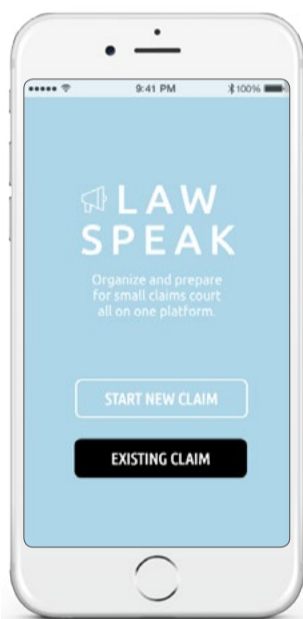

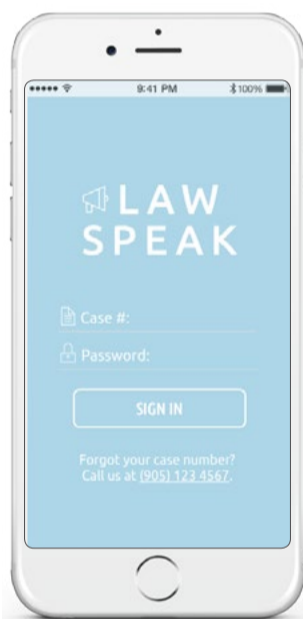
01. Home Screen

Start a new claim or open an existing claim.



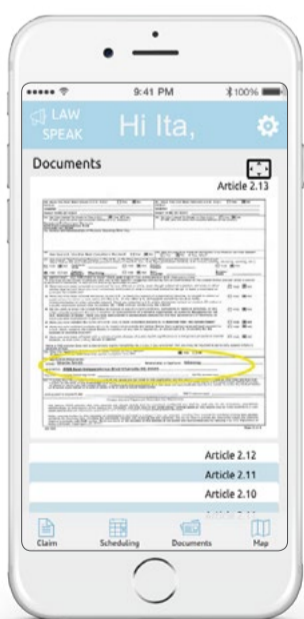
03. Sign-In Screen

Sign-in using your existing claim number to gain access to the app.



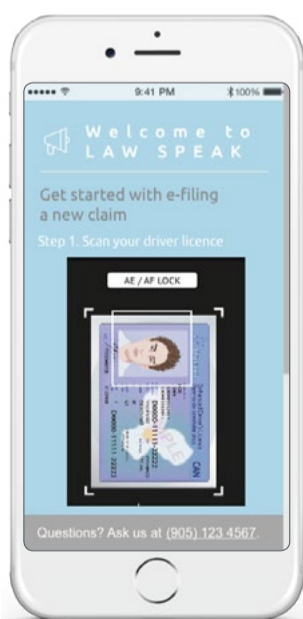
04. Claim Screen
